

PRIDE Patch Guidelines

To earn the PRIDE patch a Cub Scout, Boy Scout, Venturer or adult Scout must perform at least 4 hours of community service related to conservation. Examples of worthy projects include lake cleanups; trail maintenance, tree planting and any other project that improves the environment. Scout safety guidelines should be followed when participating in activities. All youth and adults must be registered in order to receive the award.



The award will be a patch as shown above. Awards will be given based on service performed after June 30, 2003. PRIDE has paid for the patches. The patches can be picked up at the Blue Grass Council, BSA office; or you may chose to pay the shipping fee for the patches to be mailed to you.
