The licensed installer will be responsible for applicable health department permit fees for the system installation and the local health department must inspect all systems.

A Master Plumber must perform all city sewer hookups.

- Copy of a current electric bill for the residence for which the grant application is made (The electric bill must show a physical address.)**

I understand PRIDE grant funds can be used only for the connection between my home and the new septic system or the municipal sewer and will not pay for repairs or upgrades to my existing system. I agree to correct all plumbing deficiencies, if required, prior to the installation of the connection to the new septic system or the municipal sewer.

I also agree it is my responsibility as the homeowner to ensure the electrical wiring system in my home meets all state and local regulations and is adequate to support an outside connection for a grinder pump control box, if required. I understand PRIDE grant funds cannot be used to upgrade or repair the existing electrical system. I agree to correct all electrical system deficiencies, if required, and to provide an outside electrical connection at my expense prior to the grinder pump installation.
